NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 1 to 47 Rosemount Avenue, Barnoldswick from a point outside the rear of number 1 Rosemount Avenue to a point outside the rear of number 3 Rosemount Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 2nd June 2025 until 2000 hours on 4th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Coniston Avenue – Fernbank Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Yorkshire water to install a new customer connection works to be carried out.
