STANDEN HALL DRIVE AND HILLINGDON ROAD, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. Standen Hall Drive, Burnley from its junction with Hillingdon Road to outside number 24.
 - ii. Hillingdon Road, Burnley from its junction with Standen Hall Drive to outside number 4.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 2nd June 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 13th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Hillingdon Road – Red Spar Road – Standen Hall Drive and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to excavate and lay ducting at the junction of Hillingdon Road and carry out road crossing outside existing substation works to be carried out by Aptus Utilities.
