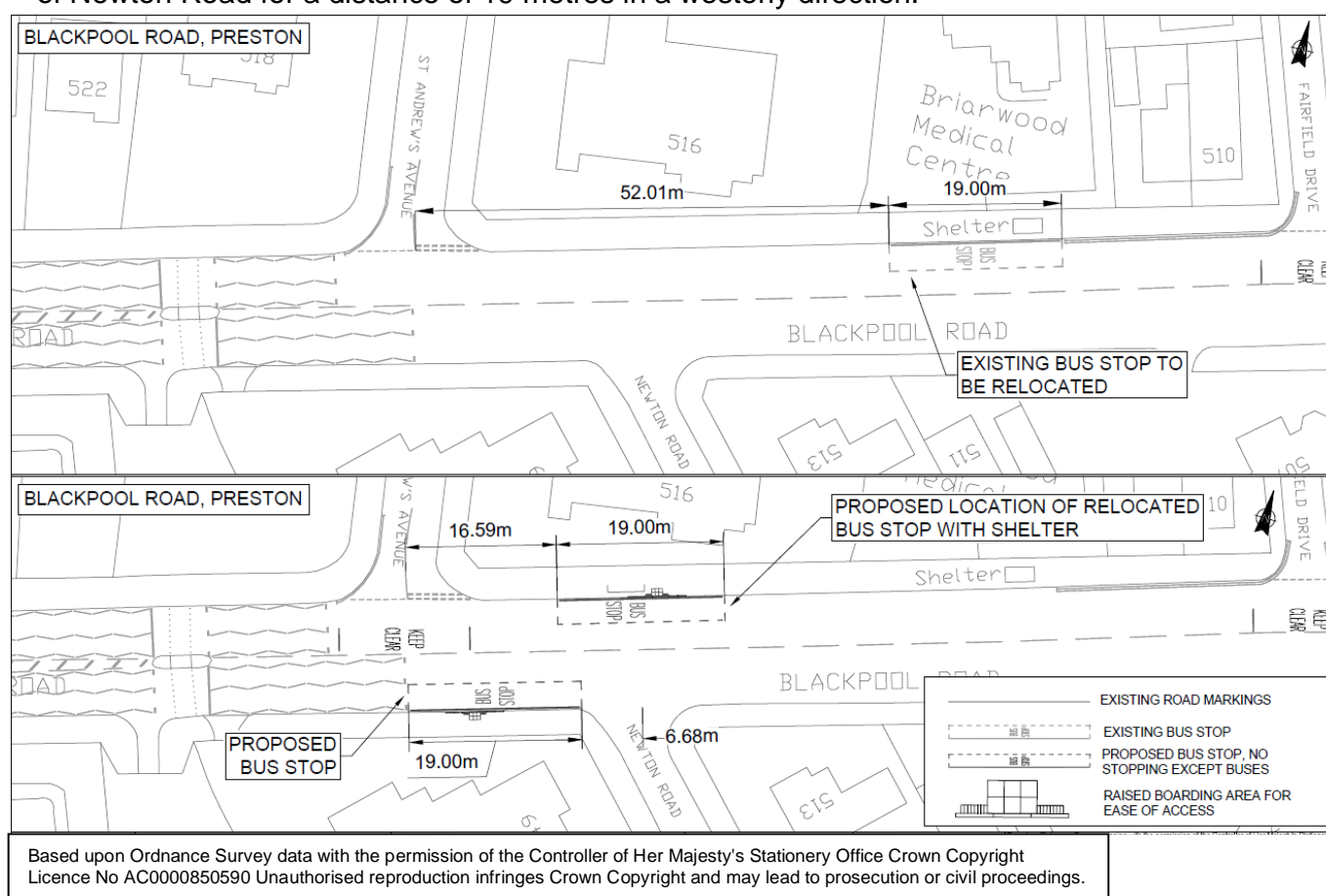


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BLACKPOOL ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(INTRODUCTION OF BUS STOP CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following

1. Remove a bus stop bus stop clearway in Blackpool Road, Preston, the north side, from a point 52.01 metres east of its junction with the centreline of St Andrew's Avenue for a distance of 19 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Introduce a Bus Stop Clearways at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Blackpool Road, Preston, the north side from a point 16.59 metres east of its junction with the centreline of St Andrew's Avenue for a distance of 19 metres in an easterly direction;
 - b) Blackpool Road, Preston, the south side, from a point 6.68 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Newton Road for a distance of 19 metres in a westerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of these proposals are to improve bus services on Blackpool Road and Tulketh Brow, Preston which is a part of the wider Bus Service Improvement Plans (BSIPs).

The proposals improve bus stop facilities and amenities of the area by introducing raised boarding areas and associated road markings allowing buses to align correctly with the raised boarding area and depart safely. These proposals will work together with proposed parking restrictions to enhance overall bus journey times for the Superbus route from Fylde into Preston City Centre.
