NEW LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCS BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of New Lane, Burscough from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0020 to 0530 on Monday 16th June 2025 or until completion of the works or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Marsh Moss Lane – Tarlscough lane – Red Cat Lane – Higgins Lane – New lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow annual Level Crossing Service works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management on behalf of Network Rail.
