(HOLLINS LANE, SILVERDALE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hollins Lane, Silverdale from a point approximately 180 metres south east from its junction with Lindeth Road for a distance of approximately 100 metres in a north westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Tuesday 24th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency service vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Hollins Lane – Lindeth Road – Stankelt Road – Hollins Lane and vice

versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access for engineers to carry out telegraph pole testing works on behalf of Openreach
