BIRCH GREEN ROAD, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCS BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of of Birch Green Road, Skelmersdale (Southbound carriageway only) from a point 180 metres south of its junction with Forest Drive for a distance of 75 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Thursday 12th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Houghtons Road – Northway – Birch Green Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms mast repair works to be carried out by Chevron TM on behalf of Vodaphone
