(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)(No.2) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Kellet Lane, Over Kellet from its junction with Netherbeck to its junction with Cappernwray Road.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 29th April 2025 until 2359 hours on Monday 19th May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridge repair works following a Bridge Strike.
