**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Kellet Lane, Over Kellet from its junction with Netherbeck to its junction with Cappernwray Road.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025 until 2359 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridge repair works following a Bridge Strike.
