(MAIN ROAD, GALGATE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Main Road, Galgate for a distance of approximately 20 metres either side of the rail bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours until 0600 on the following dates;
 - I. Sunday 3rd August 2025 until Monday 4th August 2025
 - II. Sunday 10th August 2025 until Monday 11th August 2025
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and Emergency Service vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A6 Main Road – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – A6 Scotforth Road – A6 Greaves Road – A588 Ashton Road – A588 Lancaster Road – A588 Main Road – A588 Lancaster Road – B5272 Main Street – B5272 Garstang Road – B5272 Par Lane – B5272 Cockerham Road – A6 Lancaster New Road – A6 Lancaster Road – A6 Main Road and vice versa,

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow de-vegetation works to be carried out on the retaining walls around the underbridge 78 (Four walls - one on each side of bridge).
