(STONEY BANK ROAD, EARBY, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stoney Bank Road, Earby from its junction with Stoopes Hill travelling in a westerly direction for approximately 30 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2025 until 2000 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Stoney Bank Road – Water Street – Victoria Road – A56 – Castle Road – Skipton Old Road – West Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Yorkshire Water to install new customer connection works.
