CUDDY HILL, EAVES LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Cuddy Hill, Eaves Lane, Preston from its junction with Rapley Lane to its junction with Brierley Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Tuesday 10th June 2025 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 11th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Eaves Lane – Station Lane – Garstang Road – Woodplumpton Lane – Moorside Lane – Eaves Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecommunication pole maintenance works to be carried out.
