## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(SKITHAM LANE, OUT RAWCLIFFE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Skitham Lane, Out Rawcliffe from its junction with Lancaster Road to outside property named Hillcrest.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025 until Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be always maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Longmoor Lane – Garstang Bypass Road – Cockerham Road – Park Lane – Garstang Road – Main Street – Marsh Lane – Sandside – Lancaster Road, Pilling – Bradshaw Lane – Lancaster Road, Out Rawcliffe and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
