
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bolton Avenue, Accrington from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 1000 hours to 1500 hours on Sunday 22nd June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Whinney Hill Road – Whalley Road – Queens Road – Burnley Road – Bolton Avenue and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridge examination works undertaken by Network Rail.
