BOLTON AVENUE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bolton Avenue, Accrington from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 1000 hours to 1500 hours on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Whinney Hill Road – Whalley Road – Queens Road – Burnley Road – Bolton Avenue and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridge examination works undertaken by Network Rail.
