ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(ADLINGTON STREET, CHAPEL STREET AND CHURCH STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 6 May 2025 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Revoke the following:
 - a) The "Lancashire County Council (Burnley Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
 - i. Items (7) and (80) of Schedule 10.01;
 - ii. Item (3) of Schedule 11.075.
 - b) "The Lancashire County Council (Borough of Burnley) (Top O' Town) (Residents Only Parking) Traffic Regulation Order 2003" insofar as it relates to Items (1) and (2) of Schedule 5.
- 2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Adlington Street, Burnley, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Church Street to its junction with the centreline of Hawk Street;
 - b) Chapel Street, Burnley, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Adlington Street to its junction with the centreline of Church Street.
- 3. Introduce a prohibition of loading and unloading in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Adlington Street, Burnley, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Church Street to its junction with the centreline of Hawk Street;
 - b) Chapel Street, Burnley, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Adlington Street for a distance of 32 metres in a southerly direction;
 - c) Chapel Street, Burnley, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Adlington Street for a distance of 42.5 metres in a southerly direction;
 - d) Church Street, Burnley, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Adlington Street for a distance of 29.5 metres in a southerly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 19 May 2025. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
