(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council had made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - Cowley Crescent, Padiham from its junction with Scott Street to outside number 30.
 - ii. Rear 55 to 73 Burnley Road, Padiham from its junction with Cowley crescent to outside number 71.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 30th June 2025 until 1700 hours on Monday 7th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Cowley Crescent – Padiham Road – Scott Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works for a new underground link box to be carried out by Electricity North West.
