
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bottomdale Road, Slyne from its junction with A6 Main Road for a distance of approximately 20 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Bottomdale Road – Kellet Road – Halton Road – Green Lane –  
A6 Lancaster Road – A6 Main Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out on behalf of Openreach.
