**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Grane Road, Haslingden from its junction with Waterside Road to its junction with Grane Park.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1530 hours on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via;

A56 (Haslingden Bypass) – Manchester Road – Warner Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate gas leak repair works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
