## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(NEW ROAD, SILVERDALE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of New Road, Silverdale for a distance of 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 0900 hours on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-New Road - Sand Lane - Main Street - Hyning Road - Yealand Road - Flat Lane - Footeran Lane - Silverdale Road - Storrs Lane -Slackwood Lane - New Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing inspection works to be carried out on behalf of Network Rail.
