(GRANE ROAD, HASLINGDEN, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Grane Road, Haslingden from its junction with Waterside Road to its junction with Grane Park.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A56 (Haslingden Bypass) – Manchester Road – Warner Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of gas leak repair works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
