NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Abbey Street, Accrington from Avenue parade for 152 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours from Thursday 26th June 2025 to Friday 11th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
 The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
 Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via Eastgate – King Street – Blackburn Road – Eagle Street – Paradise Street – Church Street – Oak Street – Bank Street – Black Abbey Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out on behalf of Lancashire County Council
