MOSSY LEA ROAD, WRIGHTINGTON, WEST LANCS, BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.


1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mossy Lea Road, Wrightington from Boundary lane for 230 metres in a Southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025 to 18:00 hours on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**

The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Crow Orchard Road – Shevington Lane – Almond Brook Road – School Lane – Preston Road – Springs Brow – Preston Road – Mill Lane – Park Hall Road – Wood Lane – Mossy Lea Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out on behalf of Lancashire County Council
