## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BACK LANE, GREENHALGH WITH THISTLETON, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Greenhalgh With Thistleton from outside property named Ryisle for approximately 100 metres in a southernly direction
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Weeton Road – Kirkham Wesham Bypass – Fleetwood Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
