(GLEN WAY, BRIERFIELD, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF FOOTWAY) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Glen Way, Brieffield from its junction with Pendle Road travelling in a northerly direction to a point north of Northlight Leisure Box.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 30th June 2025 until 1630 hours on 22nd August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Railway Street - Colne Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Barnfield Construction Limited to carry out footway surfacing and road repair works.
