(A588 MAIN ROAD, THURNHAM, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of A588 Main Road Thurnham for a distance of approximately 5 metres either side of the private entrance to property known as Throstle Croft.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-A588 Main Road – A588 Lancaster Road – A588 Ashton Road – A6 Greaves Road – A6 Scotforth Road – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – A6 Main Road – A6 Lancaster Road – A6 Lancaster New Road – B5272 Cockerham Road – B5272 Park Road – B5272 Garstang Road – A588 Main Street – A588 Lancaster Road – A588 Main Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus to Install 1 x long 25mm water connection to the 8" main on behalf of United Utilites.
