
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Keer Holme Lane, Borwick from its junction with Docker Lane for a distance of approximately 200 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 11th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Keer Holme Lane – Keerside – Docker Lane – B6254 Kikrby Lonsdale Road – Borwick Road – Keer Holme Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole testing works to be carried out on behalf of Openreach.
