NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Elmridge from Tanhouse for the full length.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The Order will be in force from 0800 hours on Monday 14th July 2025 to 1800 hours on Friday 25th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. No diversion required due to being a no through road.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 6. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway re surfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
