DERBY STREET WEST, ORMSKIRK, WEST LANCS BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

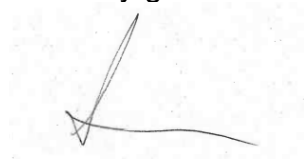
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Derby Street West, Ormskirk from outside number 4 Derby Street West for a distance of 45 metres in an easterly direction
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 20:00 hours to 05:00 hours from Thursday 24th July 2025 to Wednesday 30th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be via- Southport Road – County Road – Burscough Road and vice versa
5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
6. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway re surfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
