(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Back Rushton Avenue, Earby from a point at the rear of 15 Rushton Avenue traveling in either direction for approximately 10 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on 31st July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Vehicular and emergency services access will only be maintained whenever or wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Rushton Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Water Services to install a new customer connection works.
