## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(GREENBERFIELD LANE, BARNOLDSWICK, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed over that length of Greenberfield Lane, Barnoldswick from a point at Greenberfield Vehicular Bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 until 1700 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained when following the diversion route. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Gisburn Road – Skipton Road – Coates Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out bridge repair works.
