SANDY WAY, HOLMESWOOD, WEST LANCS BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sandy Way, Holmeswood from Mossend Cottage for a distance of 21 metres in a north westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1700 hours on Monday 21st July 2025 to Wednesday 23rd July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**

Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Tootle Lane – Brick Kiln Lane – Holmeswood Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works undertaken by Network Plus.
