

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(FACTORY BROW, SCORTON, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Factory Brow from its junction with Cleverley Bank Lane for approximately 100 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 27th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
The Square – Snowhill Lane – Higher Lane – Eidsforth Lane – Barnacre Lodge Drive – Long Lane – Strickens Lane – Oakenclough Road – long Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow an engineer to work on overhead structure for pole testing works to be carried out.
