(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING OR UNLOADING) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle from proceeding over that length of Berry Lane, Longridge in its entirety.
- 2. To temporarily prohibit any waiting, loading/unloading at any time on the north side of Kestor Lane, Longridge from its junction with Derby Road to its junction with Market Place.
- 3. To temporarily prohibit any waiting, loading or unloading at any time on the north west side of Higher Road, Longridge from the junction with Market Place/Dilworth Lane to its junction with Chaigley Road.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via -

Market Place - Kestor Lane - Derby Road

- 5. Nothing in this order shall apply to anyone taking part in this event.
- 6. The prohibition will be operative from 0600 hours to 1900 hours on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2025. (Or, at such time as, the last competitor has passed the completion point)

Access will be maintained via marshal points for residents and businesses.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable the holding of the Longridge Soapbox Race 2025
