(DELPH LANE, BARNACRE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Delph Lane, Barnacre from its junction with Hazelhead Lane to outside Forge Bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Saturday 5th July 2025 until 1700 hours on Sunday 6th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will have to follow the diversion. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
 - From the north of the closure Hazelhead Lane – Gubberford Lane – Lancaster New Road – Lancaster Road – High Street – Bridge Street – Bonds Lane – Garstang Road – New Lane – Lodge Road – Smithy Lane -Sandholme Lane – Turners Lane – Barnacre Lodge Drive
 - ii. From the east of the closure Banacre Lodge Drive - Turners Lane - Sandholme Lane – Smithy Lane – Lodge Road – New Lane – Garstang Road – Bonds Lane – Park Hill Road – Croston Road – High Street – Lancaster Road – Lancaster New Road – Gubberford Road – Hazlehead Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a new water connection works to be carried out.
