(BACK STANLEY ROAD SOUTH, HEYSHAM, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Back Stanley Road South, Heysham from its junction with Back Granville Road East to its junction with Westminster Road.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1050 hours on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025 until 1630 hours on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency sewer repair works to be carried out.
