(B5272 GARSTANG ROAD, COCKERHAM, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of B5272 Garstang Road, Cockerham from outside property known as Kingfisher Roost to its junction with Park Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 1800 hours on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-B5272 Garstang Road - B5272 Main Street – A588 Lancaster Road – A588 Main Road – A588 Lancaster Road - A588 Ashton Road – A6 Greaves Road – A6 Scotforth Road – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – A6 Main Road – A6 Lancaster Road – A6 Lancaster New Road – B5272 Cockerham Road – B5272 Park Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus to rebuild fire hydrant chamber and make hydrant accessible on behalf of United Utilities.
