NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (West Lancashire District Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to Item (2) of Schedule 2.01.
- 2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following length of road:
 - Victoria Street, Burscough, both sides, (eastern spur) from a point 130.5 metres south west then west of its junction with the centreline of Orrell Lane for a distance of 19.5 metres in a westerly direction;
 - b) Victoria Street, Burscough, both sides, (western spur) from a point 54 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Orrell Lane for a distance of 33 metres in a southerly then easterly direction.
