The purpose of this proposal is to formally revoke the disabled parking bay outside 40 Delamere Way, Upholland.

A Traffic Regulation Order was provided when the bay was applied for pre 2009, but the bay has not been marked on site for a number of years and is no longer required.

There will be no changes on site, therefore drivers will not be subject to any changes as a result of this proposal.

Concerns were raised by West Lancashire Borough Council regarding parking issues on Victoria Street and refuge vehicles experiencing problems accessing the road.

In response to the concerns, officers carried out site visits on different days and at different times of the day which confirmed the reported concerns. On all of the site visits, vehicles were observed parking on the bends.

To address the issue, officers propose to introduce a No Waiting at Any Time restriction around the bends to remove obstructive parking and assist in the general movement of traffic.
