
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SCOTLAND ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- 1) Scotland Road, Nelson, the north east side, from a point 7 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Charles Street for a distance of 18.5 metres in a north westerly direction;
- 2) Scotland Road, Nelson, the south west side, from a point 25 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Charles Street for a distance of 18.5 metres in a north westerly direction.



## **Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this scheme is to improve the amenities in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson. Two Bus Stop Clearways are to be introduced to prioritise bus services and encourage the use of public transport.
