Lancaster Road, Preston

It is therefore proposed to remove the existing No Waiting restrictions on both sides of Alston Street to allow unrestricted parking for the local residents without impacting on road safety.

Four Goods Vehicle Loading Bays within the UCLan area of Preston have been present for a number of years, however, officers have recently been made aware that the Traffic Regulation Order in the area doesn't match the restrictions as signed on site.

Enforcement patrols have observed vehicles parking within the bays resulting in businesses being unable to utilise the facilities. However, due to the inconsistencies in the Order, effective enforcement has not been possible.

To address the issue, Officers propose to formalise the current Goods Vehicle Loading Bays on site to allow for effective enforcement, with not change to the restrictions or their extents on site. Therefore, drivers will not be subject to any changes as a result of this proposal

This proposal will introduce a Limited Waiting 30 minutes no return within 1 hour 7am – 7pm to match the extent of the restriction and signs on site. It is also proposed to introduce a new taxi stand no stopping 7pm -7am, allowing taxis unobstructed access to the bay in the evenings.

Concerns had been raised by residents regarding No Waiting at Any Time restrictions that were thought to have been refreshed incorrectly. It was confirmed that the lines had been repainted correctly, however, investigations highlighted parking issues at this location.

It is proposed to introduce new No Waiting at Any Time restrictions at the junction of Sandy Lane with Pembroke Place/Balcarres Place and also reduce the extents of the existing parking restrictions at the southern end of Sandy Lane.

The purpose of this proposal is to provide extra parking provisions on the highway, without compromising the safety of other road users. The proposals will also improve the general road safety for all highway users and assist with the access and egress to the GP surgery in particularly for emergency service vehicles and larger delivery and refuse collection vehicles

Concerns have been raised by Brownedge St Mary's High School regarding restricted access to the school resulting from vehicles parking along both sides of Back Station Road.

Investigations were undertaken which revealed that parking, which appeared to be related to surrounding businesses, did have the potential to restrict access to the school, particularly for larger servicing and emergency services vehicles.

To address the issue, it is proposed to introduce No Waiting, Monday - Friday, 8 am - 4 pm restrictions along the southern extent to remove obstructive parking and assist with the general movement of traffic along the road and at the junction with Station Road, improving the general road safety for all highway users.
