

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(CHESTNUT AVENUE, EUXTON, BOROUGH OF CHORLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Chestnut Avenue, Euxton from a point 50 metres south of its junction with Shawbrook Close for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours until 17:00 hours daily, from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Chestnut Avenue – Shawbrook Close – A49 Wigan Road – Runshaw Lane – Cedar Avenue and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out.
