NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Moss Side Lane, Stalmine With Staynall from its junction with Crook Dale Lane to outside property named Woodlands Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Friday 20th June 2025 until 1500 hours on Friday 27th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent repair to subsidence road to be carried out.
