<u>NOTICE OF MAKING</u> <u>ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984</u> LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GARSTANG ROAD AND HAMPSHIRE AVENUE, BOWGREAVE, WYRE BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 23 June 2025 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- 1) Garstang Road, Bowgreave, the south west side, from a point 13 metres south east of its junction with the Centreline of Hampshire Avenue for a distance of 36 metres in a north westerly direction;
- 2) Hampshire Avenue, Bowgreave, the north west side, from its junction with the Centreline of Garstang Road for a distance of 10.5 metres in a south westerly direction;
- 3) Hampshire Avenue, Bowgreave, the south east side, from its junction with the Centreline of Garstang Road for a distance of 11.5 metres in a south westerly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 04 July 2025.
