

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(RIBBLESDALE AVENUE AND THORNEYHOLME ROAD,
ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (BUS STOP
CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:

- a) Ribblesdale Avenue, Accrington, the south side, from a point 14 metres west of its junction with the centreline of David Lloyd Way for a distance of 17 metres in a westerly direction.
- b) Thorneyholme Road, Accrington, the west side, from a point 24 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Moss Hall Road for a distance of 25 metres in a southerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops on Ribblesdale Avenue and Thorneyholme Road, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
