NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Woodside Terrace, Nelson from its junction with Dalkeith Road to its junction with Lowther Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 00:00 hours until 23:59 hours on 1st July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic is not available at this location.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities to complete urgent utility repair works.
