These are designed to empower both experienced teachers and those new to the profession with the skills needed to effectively manage and support pupil behaviour. You will find a variety of courses tailored to address classroom-level challenges, providing strategies to enhance individual teaching practices and support colleagues in managing behaviour effectively.

Additionally, we offer whole-school review sessions that delve into school culture, relational behaviour policies, and the implementation of Trauma-Informed Approaches. These sessions aim to improve outcomes for all pupils, particularly the most vulnerable, by fostering a supportive and understanding school environment.

Recognising the increasing prevalence of neurodiverse conditions, we will continue to offer cross-phase courses bridging primary and secondary education. These courses focus on understanding and supporting students with Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC), Pathological Demand Avoidance (PDA), and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD).

Computing

Welcome to the course offer for computing for 2025/2026. This outlines the range of courses that school staff can attend this school year.

We have several useful courses for those individuals who are managing this subject. Those who are new or even those who have been leading the subject for several years will find the 'New to Subject Leadership in Primary Computing' a very informative introduction to this subject. All computing subject leaders will benefit from attending the Primary Computing Subject Leader Meetings. These courses look at many different aspects that support this subject, including key updates such as those from Ofsted and DfE, new strategies and activities, and documents that subject leaders need to support their subject.

There are now three courses to support schools in using artificial intelligence effectively. These courses are aimed at different sets of users, i.e. primary schools, EYFS practitioners and governors. These courses look at this area in both a strategic manner, as well as looking at ways that artificial intelligence can be used to save time on administration tasks and help support the curriculum. They look at the issues linked to the use of this technology and its future uses.

Those teachers or subject leaders wanting to keep up to date with online safety should consider attending the 'Online Safety for Primary Schools'. This course is updated every time it is run to make sure the content is as current as possible. The course discusses key safeguarding documents, as well as considering how this area can be supported in the classroom. There is also a separate course, 'Online safety for governors', which is run every term. This subject area is a popular choice for schools to request as a school-based session for staff, pupils, or parents.

Both the 'Sticky learning in computing' course and 'Effective teaching and learning in primary computing' are suitable for both subject leaders and teaching staff. The latter looks at the core elements of this subject and how to teach it in the classroom, including how to teach programming and computational thinking. The sticky learning course looks at pupil learning in depth, including strategies on how to optimise the teaching of computing. Lastly, after getting requests from teachers, a new assessment course has been added to the course roster

Remember that all these courses can be run as school-based sessions.

Design Technology

The information below outlines the Primary Design Technology courses for 2025/2026. DT is a very practical subject and schools will often request school-based consultancies and training that are more specific to the needs of the individual school. This year, with this in mind, there is a new course focused on supporting the development of practical skills and knowledge of the more challenging aspects of the curriculum called 'Practical DT'. The content of this course will change each year.

We are happy to support these needs. Subject leaders new to this area of the curriculum, will find attending the 'New to Subject Leadership in Primary DT' course a useful introduction to fully understanding the breadth and needs of this subject. This is a practical course that discusses all areas of the primary DT curriculum. Further support for subject leaders is given through the 'Primary Design and Technology Subject Leader Network Meetings', either online or in face-to-face courses. The latter option allows the more practical elements of the sessions to be covered fully. Those subject leaders needing more support to understand assessment and progression within this subject should attend the 'Assessment and Progression in Primary DT'. This course has lots of school-based examples of work, as well as providing examples of yearly expectations. The importance of oracy, books and writing within this subject, is covered in a new course 'Reading, Writing and Oracy in Primary DT'. This is suitable for teachers and subject leaders in DT and English.

Further DT courses that would be suitable for teachers and subject leaders are 'Effective Teaching and Learning in Primary DT' and 'Sticky Learning In DT'. The latter course looks at how to help pupils enhance their learning of knowledge and skills and the importance of problem solving in DT, while the 'Effective Teaching and Learning in Primary DT' course looks at the core elements of DT for teaching and learning and spends time on the importance of evaluation and the iterative process.

The Primary English and Literacy team at LPDS always strive to offer a course programme to meet the needs of all schools with up-to-date key messages, evidence based CPD, support for leaders and practical guidance to support teaching and learning in the classroom. 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Geography

Welcome to the course offer for primary geography. In the section below we outline the different professional development opportunities for 2025/2026. The courses will help support teachers to implement the primary national curriculum for geography and how geographers work so that they can promote pupil understanding of how they can 'think, work, talk and write like a geographer'.

Some courses are specific to subject leaders. The New to Subject Leadership in Primary Geography looks at how subject leaders can plan, implement, moderate, and assess their primary geography curriculum. Every term there is an opportunity to attend the Geography Subject Leader Network Meetings. This looks at all the key areas of the geography curriculum and keeps subject leaders up-to-date with reports from Ofsted and new resources. If subject leaders want to find more detailed information on assessment, then 'Assessment and Progression in Primary Geography' would be an ideal choice. This not only covers assessment expectations and Ofsted advice but also looks at practical activities and school examples.

Those subject leaders or teachers wanting to learn about how to work like a geographer should attend 'Supporting fieldwork and geographical skills in Primary Geography'. This is a practical course looking at progressive activities from EYFS to Year 6. It is also a popular choice for a school-based training session. One of the aims of geography is to support pupils to write at length.' How to write like a Geographer (Reading, Writing and Oracy in Geography)' looks at writing, reading and oracy progressively in geography, looking at school examples and a whole range of activities that can be used to encourage these elements in this subject. This might appeal to teachers and subject leaders for geography or English.

Any teacher of geography would find the courses 'Effective teaching and learning in primary geography' and 'Migration, Democracy and Diversity in Primary Geography', useful in their support of teaching this subject. The former is a more general course, looking at all areas of geography and providing advice on how to implement the subject in the classroom, while the latter, a new course, highlights the importance of geography in the curriculum, linking this subject with many other aspects of the primary curriculum. There is also a course for geography and sustainability leaders, 'Supporting Sustainability in Primary Geography'. This looks at all the possible opportunities to support sustainability in this subject, including those for fieldwork and geographical skills.

Lastly, there is a new course on 'Adaptive Teaching in Primary Geography'. This looks at how teachers can use a range of strategies to meet the diverse needs of all learners in their classroom in this subject.

Remember that all these courses can be run as school-based sessions.

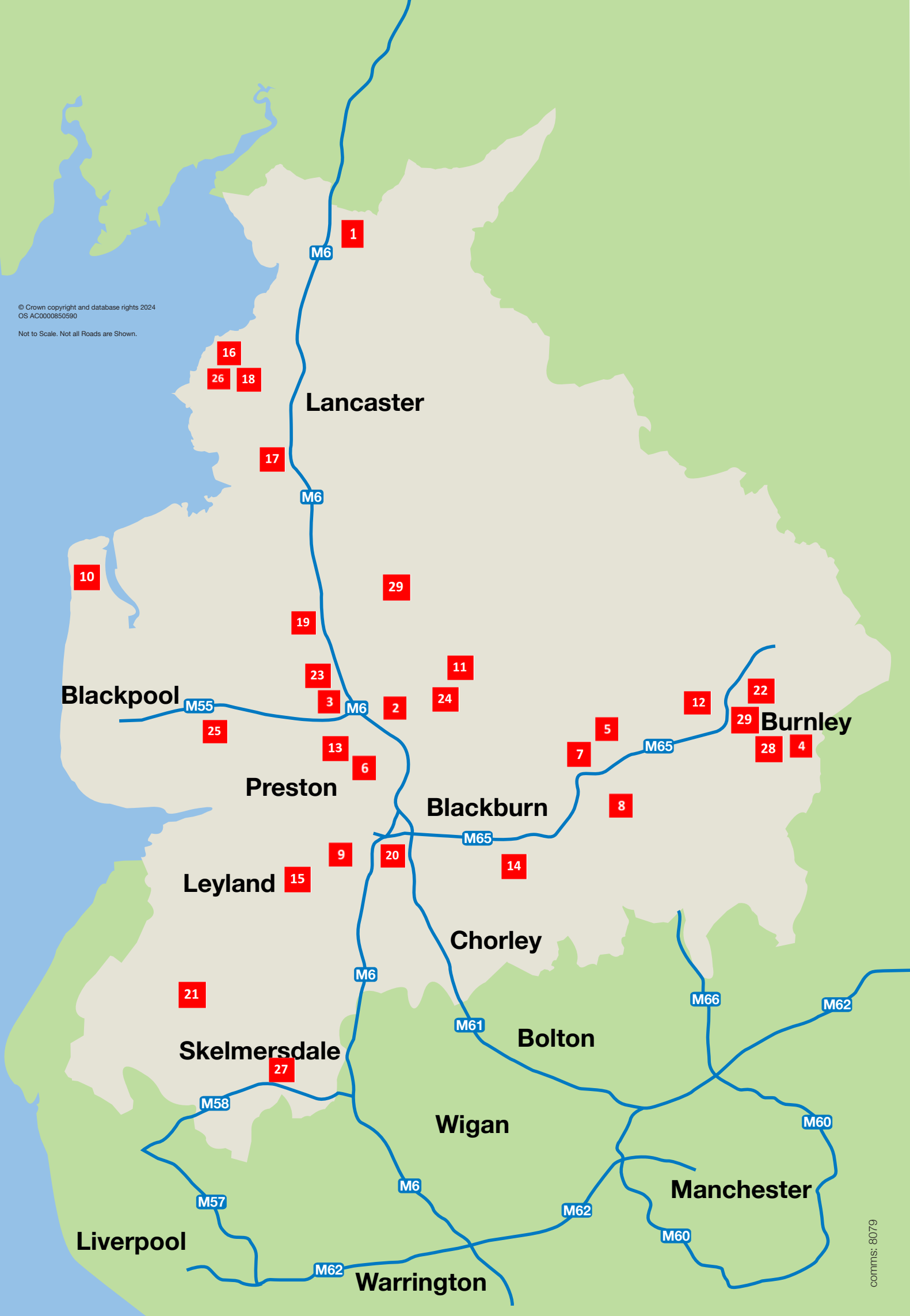
