(KENILWORTH ROAD, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Kenilworth Road, Lytham St Annes from a point outside number 53 travelling in either direction for approximately 15 metres.
2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on 28th June 2025 until 2359 hours on 2nd July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works to repair a sewer in the carriageway.
