(TEMPORARY AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024

The Lancashire County Council (“the County Council”) in exercise of its powers under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, (the Act), and of all other enabling powers, **HEREBY** makes the following Order:-


The Lancashire County Council (BACK LANE AND STUMP HALL ROAD, HIGHAM, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025, is hereby temporarily Amended in that:

- i. To amend Article as 3 follows:

The prohibition will be operative daily from 0600 hours until 1800 hours on 12th May 2025 until 14th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016

This Temporary Amendment Order shall come into operation on 28th June 2025 and may be cited as “**The Lancashire County Council (BACK LANE AND STUMP HALL ROAD, HIGHAM, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025 (TEMPORARY AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024**”
