(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Colne Road, Trawden from its junction with Burnley Road to its junction with Trawden Hill.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
1. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 11th August 2025 until 1800 hours on 13th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
2. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Church Street – Skipton Road – Trawden Road – Cotton Tree Lane – Keighley Road – Carry Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Coreline Fibre to carry out essential maintenance works.
