## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(COLNE ROAD, TRAWDEN, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Colne Road, Trawden from its junction with Burnley Road to its junction with Trawden Hill.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 1. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 1800 hours on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 2. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Church Street – Skipton Road – Trawden Road – Cotton Tree Lane – Keighley Road – Carry Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Coreline Fibre to carry out essential maintenance works.
